Individual research presentations continue, with brief discussion after each.

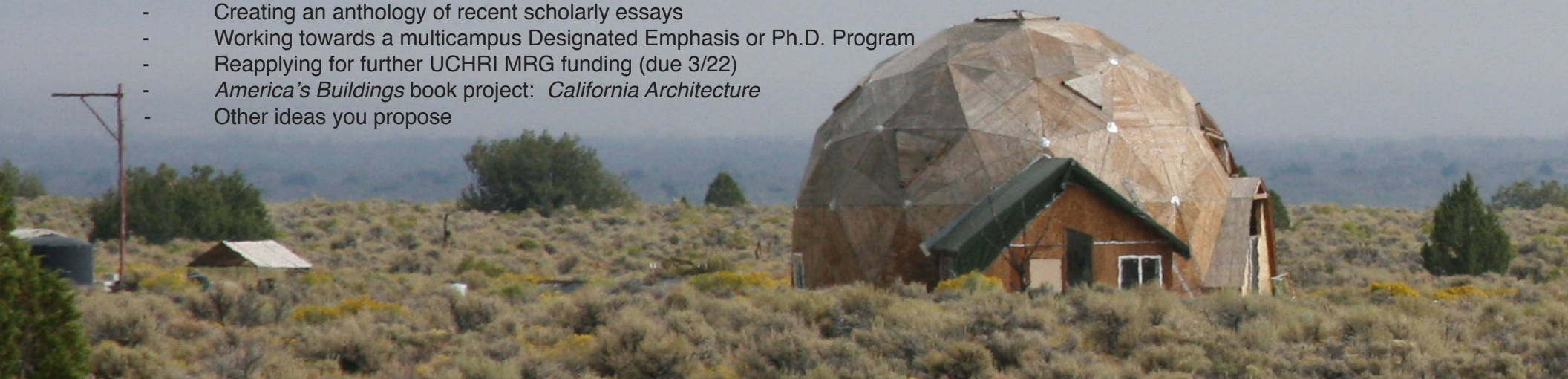

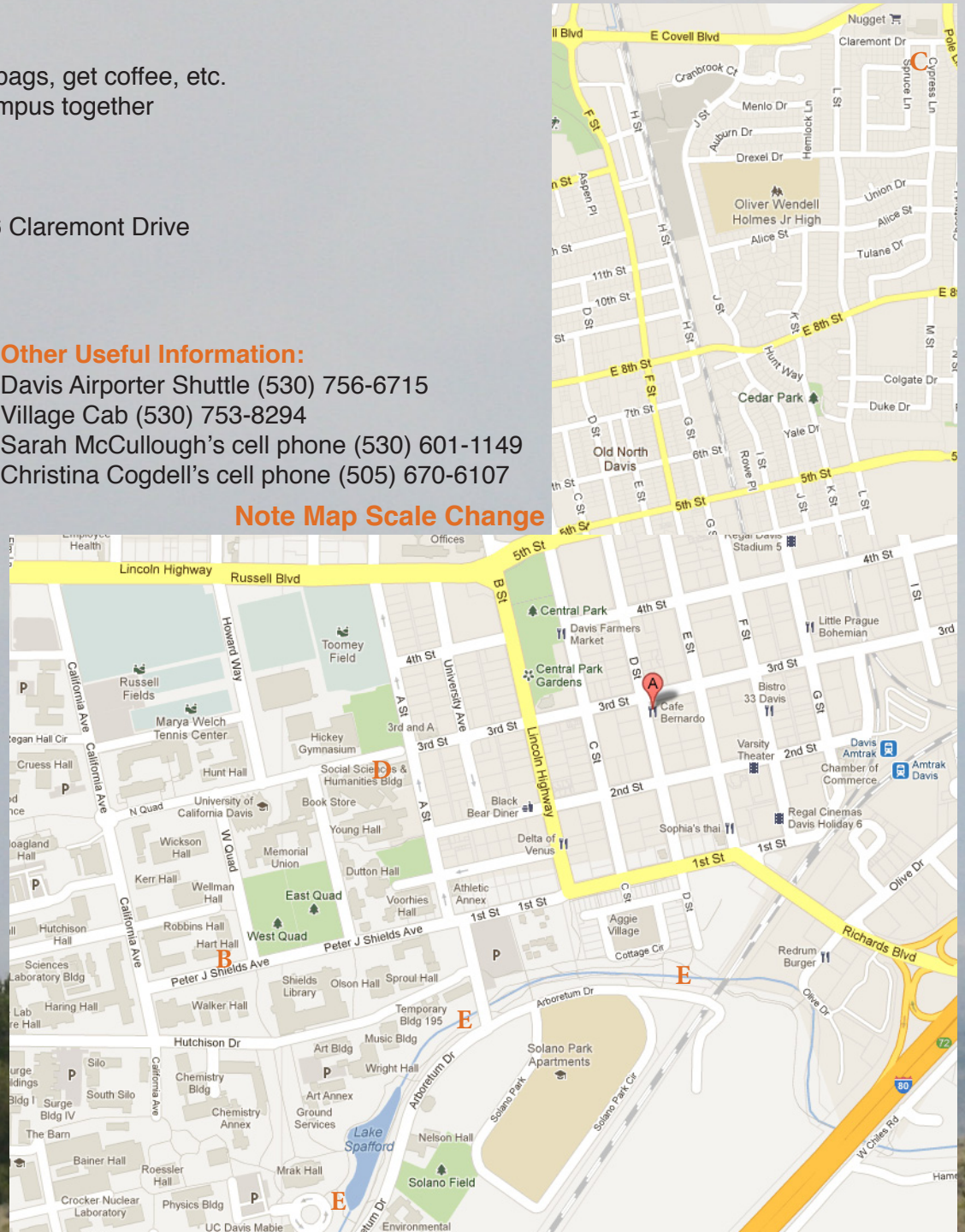
